SCRIPTURE

<u>Proverbs 14:30 -</u> 30 A sound mind makes for a robust body, but runaway emotions corrode the bones.

<u>II Corinthians 11:1-3 - 1</u> Will you put up with a little foolish aside from me? Please, just for a moment. <u>2</u> The thing that has me so upset is that I care about you so much - this is the passion of God burning inside me! I promised your hand in marriage to Christ, presented you as a pure virgin to her husband. <u>3</u> And now I'm afraid that exactly as the Snake seduced Eve with his smooth patter, you are being lured away from the simple purity of your love for Christ.

<u>Proverbs 27:4 - 4</u> We're blasted by anger and swamped by rage, but who can survive jealousy?

Romans 12:5 - 5 The body we're talking about is Christ's body of chosen people. Each of us finds our meaning and function as a part of his body. But as a chopped-off finger or cut-off toe we wouldn't amount to much, would we? So since we find ourselves fashioned into all these excellently formed and marvelously functioning parts in Christ's body,

<u>Proverbs 23:17-18 - 17</u> Don't for a minute envy careless rebels; soak yourself in the Fear-of-God - <u>18</u> That's where your future lies. Then you won't be left with an armload of nothing.

<u>Proverbs 24:19-20 - 19</u> Don't bother your head with braggarts or wish you could succeed like the wicked. <u>20</u> Those people have no future at all; they're headed down a dead-end street.
