

NO LONGER BOUND – WALK WITH GOD!


Breaking Free from the Bondage We Agreed to That Enslaves Our Heart – Jeremiah 40:4,5 & Galatians 5:1.

Many Christians don't realize that we can make agreements with the enemy of our souls to escape our past pains –whether it be from our performance, relationships, reputation, fear, or loss of control. Even though we have been totally saved from the consequences of our sin, we can still live as a slave to Satan himself because of conscious and unconscious contractual agreements we have made in our hearts.

NO LONGER BOUND: REALITY.

- 1. WAR → "Until we come to terms with war as the context of our days, we will not understand life." Arm yourself (Eph. 6:10-18).
- 2. HEART → The story of your life is the story of the long and brutal assault on your heart by the one who knows what you could be and fears it. You SEE this!
- 3. MISSION → Jesus's mission is to restore your heart. "I am here to give you back you heart and set your free." See Isaiah 61:1-4.




NO LONGER BOUND: RESORED – Ezekiel 36:26-27.

- 1. TRANSFORMATION → Moral living is not the solution. The problem is not in your behavior; the problem is in us (Matthew 15:19). We don't need an upgrade. We need transformation. We need a miracle.
- 2. NO SHAME EMBRACE YOUR
 GLORY → We fear our glory! Pride is a bad thing, to be sure, but it's not prideful to embrace the truth that you bear the image of God. Paul says it brings glory to God. We fear our own glory because we fear allowing others to see our truest self and that feels naked. See II Cor. 3:16-18.


NO LONGER BOUND: walk with god! Matthew 7:14.

1. <u>Guidance</u> → God speaks to me! He has guided me into all sorts of beautiful surprises and adventures. If you're not pursuing a dangerous quest with your life, well, then, you don't need a Guide! See Psalm 16:11. That is Discipleship! Only by walking with God can we hope to find the path that leads to life. That is what it means to be a disciple. After all—aren't we "followers of Christ"? Then by all means, let's actually follow him.



NO LONGER BOUND: walk with god! – HOW? Matthew 7:14.


- 2. By WISDOM → Our heart has been made good by the work of Christ, but we haven't leaned how to live from it. Launching out with an untrained heart can bring much hurt and ruin, and afterward we will be shamed back into the gospel of Sin Management, having concluded that our heart is bad. See Proverbs 1:32-33; 2:9-11.
- 3. By REVELATION → The Bible is full of counterintuitive direction from God. See Acts 9:1,2 and 9:13-14.



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- 1. By LISTENING → God still speaks! (John 16:12,13 & 8:47 & 10:1-4, 11). Walking with God is a way of life. It's something to be learned; our ability to hear God's voice and discern his work to us grows over time. We must learn to ASK and LISTEN!
- 2. PAY ATTENTION TO YOUR HEART → Hearing God's voice comes to us from within, in the heart, the dwelling place of God. I must test what I hear. Any "word" that brings discouragement, condemnation, accusation—that is NOT from God. (See II Cor. 7:10).





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3. <u>LISTEN TO CLOSE FRIENDS</u> →

We need men who walk with God to also walk us through the seasons of life. However, few there are who find such friends. Approach the Bible not so much as a manual of Christians principles but as the testimony of God's friends on what it means to walk with him through a thousand different episodes.
